if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion,

² make my joy complete

by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.

³ Do nothing [c]from [d]selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; ⁴ do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

- ⁵ Have this attitude <u>lelin yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus</u>,
 ⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God,
 did not regard equality with God a thing to be <u>legrasped</u>,
 ⁷ but <u>leglemptied Himself</u>,
 taking the form of a bond-servant,
 and being made in the likeness of men.
 - ⁸ Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death [h]on a cross.
 - ⁹ For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
