

# Message: ***"God Sent His Son"***

**Scripture:** Mark 12:1-11  
(12-07-25 Pastor Tony Hao)

*Who do you think you are?* is a question used to express anger, disbelief, or indignation when someone is acting inappropriately, overstepping their boundaries, or behaving in a way that is perceived as arrogant or disrespectful. That's what the religious leaders think of Jesus at that time.

Jesus often responded to those who questioned Him, and why He came, through parables. In the story called "Parable of the Tenants" He teaches four foundational truths about God's plan: (1) We don't own anything; We just manage some of God's property. (2) God sends many servants to communicate His will. (3) God sent His Son to convince us to respond to His offer. (4) If we reject God's Son, we will fall under His judgment.

Jesus is the precious rock God has given us to be the anchor of our lives. Will you come to the rock today? Will you build your life upon Him? Have you accepted His Son? Is your life build upon the Rock of Ages?

## **GROWING DEEPER (Reflection & Application)**

1. If you had to entrust your business or belongings to someone outside your family, who would you choose? Why?
2. What does the vineyard represent? Who is the owner? The son? Who are the tenants? The servants? What was Jesus prophesying by telling this story?
3. What impact did this parable have on its first hearers? How did it answer the question about Jesus' authority (11:28)?
4. How do you make Jesus feel welcome in your life each day? What actions of yours might make Him feel unwelcome?
